**AWARDS:**

COACHES ACCREDITATION:

Coaches must be a minimum of NCCP Regional Coach in Training and must meet the following accreditation standards:

- be a current professional coaching member of Skate Canada
- hold a valid First Aid Certificate

Coaches must register in person.

ON-SITE REGISTRATION:

Will begin one hour prior to the start of scheduled category.

MEDAL PRESENTATIONS:

Medals presentations will be scheduled and posted in the arena. **Skaters are asked to wear competition outfits and skates.**
