ENTRY INFORMATION

Event Registration: Registration will be available online at https://skatenf.uplifterinc.com beginning at NOON on **Wednesday, October 29, 2025**. The deadline for registration is **Friday, November 7, 2025**.

All registration and payment must be completed online. Methods of payment include: VISA, MasterCard and Discover Card. *Note: PrePaid VISA/MasterCard gift cards are also accepted online. **LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED**

REFUND POLICY: Refund requests must be made before **Friday, November 7, 2025**. After this date, all refunds will require a medical note and are subject to a \$25 administration fee (per category).

NOTES

- There is an \$8.00 Officials and Technology Development fee INCLUDED per skater. The ODF is charged only once per skater and will be discounted for skaters in multiple categories.
- Registration includes one digital action photo, from Jared Reid Studios. Information on how to redeem the photo will be sent to participants following the Event.
- Practice ice will be available for PreNovice & higher categories only.
- **Dance and Pairs:** Each skater must register separately and ensure their Uplifter profile is up to date with partner details.
- **PreNovice & Novice:** The Skate NL Sectional Championships are the qualifying Event for Skate Canada Trophy. Please refer to Skate Canada for all necessary information for qualifying Events.

REGISTRATION

(1) **REGISTRATION:** Competitors must register for the competition before their official practice session, prior to the first portion of their category. Registration for skaters, officials and coaches will commence 30 minutes prior to the start of the first practice or 60 minutes prior to the start of the category, if practices are not included.

ACCREDITATION FOR COACHES

To receive accreditation, Skate Canada professional coaches must meet the following conditions:

- > Meet the NCCP Requirements* for the level of athlete attending with
- Be a current Professional Coaching Member of Skate Canada, In Good Standing



*Refer to the <u>Coach Accreditation Policy for Skate Canada Qualifying Events</u> for details on NCCP Requirements for qualifying categories. For all additional categories, coaches must be Regional Coach In-Training.

Two coaches per entry will be accredited. Only two people will be allowed at ice level – determined by the skater/team.

MUSIC

<u>All music must be submitted electronically with online registration</u>. Please ensure correct music files are uploaded. Music file changes and mislabeled music files will be charged a \$25 administrative fee. Skaters/Coaches should have a **USB** copy of music available at ice level, during the Event. CD's, phones, or other personal devices will **NOT** be accepted.

MUSIC UPLOAD INFORMATION:

- Music must be submitted for <u>all</u> categories/segments (ie: short program, free program etc.).
- Music files <u>must</u> be MP3.
- Music uploads <u>must</u> be named in the following format: First Name Last Name Category
 Program Type
- First and Last Name <u>must</u> match the athlete's name as written on their Uplifter profile.

Category Program Type includes:

• Category (ie: STAR 5)

• **Discipline** (ie: Women/Girls, Men/Boys)

• **Segment** (ie: Short Program or Free Program, if applicable)

• Age category (ie: U10, if applicable)

Examples:

John Smith - STAR 5 Men 13&Over Suzie Smith - PreNovice Women Short Program

All music used must be legally obtained and covered by the collective societies who manage music performance rights, reprography, and mechanical reproduction rights in Canada. Competitors who have music composed specifically for their programs either wholly or in part, that has been significantly mixed or altered from the original recording, are also responsible for obtaining the appropriate licenses to create a derivative work for the compositions and sound recordings selected.

PLANNED PROGRAM SHEETS

Planned Program Content Sheets must be submitted electronically, by **Wednesday, November 12, 2025**, for the following categories:

- STAR 5 & higher STARSkate Singles categories
- PreJuvenile & higher Competitive Singles, Pairs, and Ice Dance (Free Dance only) categories

NOTE: Skaters must complete a separate form for each program, including for combined categories. Dance/Pair teams please only submit one form per team.

MEDALS

Pre-Novice & higher: In the case of only one entry in a category, an exhibition shall be performed, and no medal shall be awarded.

All additional categories: Medals shall be awarded to the top three placements in each category. In a category where there are less than three entries, then the number of medals awarded shall equal the number of entries.

Medals will be presented on-site. Skaters are asked to wear competition outfits and skates.
