Notes:

- All categories are subject to the availability of officials.
- There is an additional \$8.00 officials and technology development fee (ODF) per skater.
- Registration includes one digital action photo, per category, from Jared Reid Studios. Information on how to redeem the photo will be sent to participants following the Event.
- Dance/Pairs: Each skater must register separately and ensure their Uplifter profile is up to date with partner details.

ONLINE REGISTRATION:

Registration for all categories will take place on the Skate NL Registration website: <u>https://skatenf.uplifterinc.com</u>. Methods of payment include: VISA, MasterCard and Discover Card. PrePaid VISA/MasterCard gift cards are also accepted.

Registration Opens: Tuesday, January 7, 2025, at NOON **Registration Deadline:** Thursday, January 16, 2025 Late entries will NOT be accepted.

REFUND POLICY:

Refund requests must be made by the deadline for registration. After this date, all refunds will require a medical note and are subject to a \$25 administration fee. Medical notes must be submitted within 14 days following the Event.

AGE RESTRICTIONS:

Age is considered to be the age of the skater before July 1, preceding the Event. **NOTE:** There is no upper age limit for STARSkate categories.



ELIGIBILITY:

• Skaters who participated in a qualifying category (PreNovice and higher) at the Skate NL Sectional Championships, in the current year, are ineligible for a STARSkate category, in the same discipline, at the Provincial Championships.

ASSESSMENT QUALIFYING DEADLINE:

Assessment requirements must be met at the time of online registration.

MUSIC:

All music must be submitted electronically with online registration. *Please ensure correct music files are uploaded.* <u>Music file changes and mislabeled music files will be charged a \$25 administrative fee</u>. Skaters/Coaches should have a **USB** copy of music available at ice level, during the Event. CD's, phones, or other personal devices will **NOT** be accepted.

MUSIC UPLOAD INFORMATION:

- Music must be submitted for <u>all</u> categories/segments (ie: short program, free program etc.).
- Music files <u>must</u> be MP3.
- Music uploads <u>must</u> be named in the following format: First Name Last Name Category Program Type
- First and Last Name **must** match the athlete's name as written on their Uplifter profile.

Category Program Type includes:

- Category (ie: STAR 5)
- **Discipline** (ie: Women/Girls, Men/Boys)
- Segment (ie: Short Program or Free Program, if applicable)
- Age category (ie: U10, if applicable)

Examples:

John Smith - STAR 5 Men 13&Over Suzie Smith - PreNovice Women Short Program

COACHES ACCREDITATION:

Coaches must be a minimum of NCCP Regional Coach In-Training and be a current Professional Coaching Member of Skate Canada, in Good Standing.

SCHEDULE:

A detailed schedule will be posted on the Skate NL website as soon as possible after the registration deadline.

MEDALS:

Medals shall be awarded to the top three placements in each category. In a category where there are less than three entries, the number of medals awarded shall equal the number of entries.

MEDAL PRESENTATIONS:

Medals presentations will be scheduled and posted in the Arena. Skaters are asked to wear competition outfits and skates.



QUALIFYING CATEGORIES:

Provincials is a qualifying Event for the Atlantic Canada Skating Championships. The Atlantic Canada Skating Championships will be held April 4-6, 2025 in Nova Scotia. More information will be distributed to qualifiers at the Provincial Championships.

ACCIDENTS / LIABILITY:

Skate Canada, the Newfoundland and Labrador Section, and the local volunteer team undertake no responsibility for damages or injuries suffered by skaters.
