2025 Skate NL Summer Skate Competition Announcement

DATE: August 8-10, 2025

LOCATION: CBS Arena, CBS, NL (Ice Surface 200x85)

PreJuvenile	Ice Dance	\$120 (per team)
Juvenile-Senior	Ice Dance	\$120 (per team, per segment)
STAR	Ice Dance	\$120 (per team)
Juvenile	Pairs	\$120 (per team)
PreNovice-Senior	Pairs	\$120 (per team, per segment)

Notes:

- All categories are subject to the availability of officials.
- **There is an additional \$8.00 officials and technology development fee (ODF) per skater.**
- **Dance/Pairs:** Each skater must register separately and ensure their Uplifter profile is up to date with partner details.
- PreNovice-Senior Singles, Pairs, and Dance categories are not combined categories and will not be a combined result. Skaters must register separately for each segment.

ONLINE REGISTRATION:

Registration will take place online at the Skate Canada NL Registration website:

<https://skatenf.uplifterinc.com> Methods of payment include VISA, MasterCard and Discover Card. Pre-Paid VISA/MasterCard gift cards are also accepted.

Registration Opens: Monday, July 7, 2025, at NOON

Registration Closes: Tuesday, July 15, 2025

Late entries will NOT be accepted.

REFUND POLICY: Refund requests must be made before **Tuesday, July 15**. After this date, all refunds will require a medical note and are subject to a \$25 administration fee (per Event). Medical notes must be submitted within **14 days** following the Event.

MEDALS & MEDAL PRESENTATIONS (STAR 4 & higher):

Medals shall be awarded to the top three placements in each category. In a category where there are less than three entries, then the number of medals awarded shall equal the number of entries. Medal presentation times will be scheduled and posted in the Arena. **Skaters are asked to wear competition outfits and skates.**

MEDAL/CERTIFICATE PRESENTATIONS (STAR 1-3):

Presentation times will take place following the completion of each group.

MUSIC:

All music must be submitted electronically with online registration. ***Please ensure correct music files are uploaded.*** Music file changes and mislabeled music files will be charged a \$25 administrative fee. Skaters/Coaches should have a **USB** copy of music available at ice level, during the Event. CD's, phones, or other personal devices will **NOT** be accepted.

MUSIC UPLOAD INFORMATION:

- Music must be submitted for **all** categories/segments (ie: short program, free program etc.).
- Music files **must** be MP3.
- Music uploads **must** be named in the following format: **First Name Last Name - Category Program Type**
- First and Last Name **must** match the athlete's name as written on their Uplifter profile.

Category Program Type includes:

- **Category** (ie: STAR 5)
- **Discipline** (ie: Women/Girls, Men/Boys)
- **Segment** (ie: Short Program or Free Program, if applicable)
- **Age category** (ie: U10, if applicable)

Examples:

John Smith - STAR 5 Men 13&Over

Suzie Smith - PreNovice Women Short Program

PLANNED PROGRAM SHEETS:

Planned Program Content Sheets must be submitted with online registration for the following categories:

- STAR 5 & higher STARSkate Singles categories
- PreJuvenile & higher Competitive Singles, Pairs, and Ice Dance (Free Dance only) categories
- AdultSkate categories

Planned Program Sheets can be found here: [Resources - Skate Newfoundland & Labrador](#) and must be submitted as a .pdf or .doc file. **Planned Program Sheets will not be accepted in person at the Event.**

Note: Short Program and Free Program Sheets, in the same discipline, can be completed on the same form.

COACHES ACCREDITATION:

Coaches must be a minimum of NCCP Regional Coach In-Training and be a current Professional Coaching Member of Skate Canada, in Good Standing.

SCHEDULE:

A detailed schedule will be posted on the Skate NL website as soon as possible after the deadline for registration.
