ENTRY FEES:

STAR 6 & higher	Synchronized Skating	\$450 (per team) + \$43 per skater
Adult I, II, III	Synchronized Skating	\$450 (per team) + \$43 per skater
STAR 4	Synchronized Skating	\$250 (per team) + \$33 per skater
STAR 5, 7, 9, Gold, Gold OPEN	Artistic	\$113 *includes \$8 ODF
Intro Open-Masters Elite	Adult Singles	\$113 *includes \$8 ODF
Bronze-Gold	Adult Free Dance	\$161 (per team) *\$8 ODF per skater

Notes:

- Synchro: The per skater fee should be paid in full for all skaters, for each team they skate on. Discounts are not given for skaters on multiple teams.
- Artistic/Adult: There is an \$8.00 officials and technology development fee (ODF) **INCLUDED** per skater. The ODF is paid once per skater and will be discounted for skaters in multiple Artistic/Adult categories.
- Registration includes a digital action photo (Artistic/Adult) or team photo (Synchro) from Jared Reid Studios. Information on how to redeem the photo will be sent to participants following the Event.

ONLINE REGISTRATION:

Registration for all categories will take place on the Skate NL Registration website:

<https://skatenf.uplifterinc.com>. Methods of payment include: VISA, MasterCard and Discover Card. PrePaid VISA/MasterCard gift cards are also accepted.

Registration Opens: Wednesday, February 4, 2026, at NOON

Registration Deadline: Friday, February 13, 2026 *Late entries will NOT be accepted.

SYNCRHO: See Appendix A for detailed registration instructions. Registration will only be accepted from teams registered with Skate Canada for the current season. Clubs/Team Managers are responsible to ensure all skaters and teams are registered with Skate Canada before completing online registration.

REFUND POLICY:

Synchro: Registration fees will be refunded only if the Event is not held or if the entry is withdrawn before the registration deadline. After the closing date of entries, there will be no refunds given, for any reason.

Artistic/Adult: Refund requests must be made by the registration deadline. After this date, all refunds require a medical note and are subject to a \$25 administration fee. Medical notes must be submitted within 14 days of the Event.

AGE RESTRICTIONS:

Age is considered to be the age of the skater before July 1, preceding the Event.

ASSESSMENT QUALIFYING DEADLINE:

Assessment requirements must be met at the time of online registration.

SCHEDULE:

A schedule will be posted on the Skate NL website as soon as possible after the registration deadline.

MUSIC:

All music used must be legally obtained and covered by the collective societies who manage music performance rights, reprography, and mechanical reproduction rights in Canada. Competitors who have music composed specifically for their programs either wholly or in part, that has been significantly mixed or altered from the original recording, are also responsible for obtaining the appropriate licenses to create a derivative work for the compositions and sound recordings selected.

All music must be submitted electronically with online registration. Please ensure correct music files are uploaded. Music file changes and mislabeled music files will be charged a \$25 administrative fee. Teams/Coaches should have a USB copy of music available at ice level, during the Event. Phones or other personal devices will NOT be accepted.

ARTISTIC/ADULT MUSIC UPLOAD INFORMATION:

- Music uploads must be named in the following format: **First Name Last Name - Category Program Type (ie: STAR 5 Artistic)**
- First and Last Name must match the athlete's name as written on their Uplifter profile.

SYNCHRO MUSIC UPLOAD INFORMATION:

- Music uploads must be named in the following format: **Home Club – Category - Team Name**

PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT FORMS:

Completed forms must be submitted, using the link below, **Wednesday, February 18, 2026**. There will be a \$25 fee for missing, incomplete, or incorrect forms.

COACHES ACCREDITATION:

Coaches must be a minimum of NCCP Regional Coach In-Training and be a current Professional Coaching Member of Skate Canada, in Good Standing.

MEDALS:

Medals shall be awarded to the top three placements in each category. In a category where there are less than three entries, the number of medals awarded shall equal the number of entries. **Skaters must wear competition outfits and skates for all presentations.**

SYNCHRO ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- **On-Site Registration:** All teams, coaches, and team managers must register on-site. Only those skaters included in the original team numbers will be permitted to skate. No substitutions or additions are allowed. The number of allowable alternates on each team is four.



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- **Team Managers and Chaperones:** All team managers and chaperones must be current Skate Canada registrants. Two coaches, one team manager, and two chaperones will be accredited. Coaches and one alternate (skater) will stand at the entrance to the ice, and the team manager and other alternates in the exit area (Kiss & Cry). The chaperones will be allowed in the dressing rooms ONLY and will not have access to ice level during competition (including Kiss & Cry).

ACCIDENTS / LIABILITY:

Skate Canada, the Newfoundland and Labrador Section, and the local volunteer team undertake no responsibility for damages or injuries suffered by skaters. As a condition of and in consideration of their entries in these Championships, all competitors and their parents or guardians shall be deemed to agree to assume all risks or injuries to the competitor's person and property resulting from, or caused by or connected with, the conduct and management of the competitions and to release any and all claims they may have against the officials, the association, the Section, the Skate Canada, the volunteer team and against their officers and their entries shall be accepted only on these conditions.

Synchronized Skating Registration Instructions

1. Set up an Account:

- Go to the Skate Canada NL Registration website (<https://skatenf.uplifterinc.com>)
- Click “Login” at the top of the page.
- Follow the instructions under “First Time Registering?” OR login to an existing Skate Canada NL Uplifter team account.
- If creating a new account or adding a new team enter the following:
 - Email Address – Team managers will either:
 - Create a new profile with a unique email address for their team (RECOMMENDED) OR
 - Add the **team** as a new participant under an existing Skate Canada NL Uplifter profile (login and under “My Account” enter the team as a new participant)
 - **NOTE:** You should not add team members as individual participants
 - First Name – Enter the “Home Club”
 - Last Name – Enter the “Team Name”
 - If you have created a unique profile for your team, click on “I will be registering myself into programs”.
 - At the bottom of the page click “Yes” to subscribe to all message lists to receive important information/updates regarding the competition.
- Once you have set up the account, you will be brought back to the main page.

2. Complete Team and Skater Registration:

- Click on the event name under the “Registration” tab
- Choose the category or under “Quick Search”, enter your category (ie: STAR 4)
- Click the “Register” button. A box will appear asking you to choose the participant for this program. Ensure this is the team’s name.
- Go to your “Shopping Cart” to complete the registration.
- Click on “Purchase Products” to add the Per Skater Registration.
- Under “Items for Purchase”, choose Synchro Skater Registration enter the number of skaters on the team in the “QTY” box, click “Add”
- In your Shopping Cart, proceed with payment. Note: You must accept all associated policies to proceed with the registration.
- After you have successfully completed the payment process, you will receive an electronic invoice via email.
